God's ID~ Wisdom

"Who could ever wrap their minds around the riches of God, the depth of his wisdom, and the marvel of his perfect knowledge? Who could ever explain the wonder of his decisions or search out the mysterious way he carries out his plans."

~Romans 11:33

God makes no mistakes. We have to trust that we have a perfect God no matter what our circumstances are.

my id~ Godly Wisdom

"And if anyone longs to be wise, ask God for wisdom, and he will give it! He won't see your lack of wisdom as an opportunity to scold you over your failures, but he will overwhelm your failures with generous grace."

~James 1:5

God gives us His wisdom when we ask for it. And when we lack wisdom, He covers us with His abundant grace.

God's ID~ Sovereign

"He does what he pleases, with unlimited power and authority, extending his greatness throughout the entire universe!"

~Psalms 135:6

God rules all of creation. God is in control of everything good that happens.

my id~ Authority Through Christ

"But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a victory over those people because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world."

~1John 4:4

We are granted authority over the enemy in Christ Jesus. Because we belong to Jesus, we have the same Spirit that conquered death living inside of us to claim victory in our lives.

God's ID~ Infinite

"How great is our God! There's absolutely nothing his power cannot accomplish, and he has infinite understanding of everything."

~Psalms 147:5


Our God is infinite, He has no boundaries and there's no ceiling to what God can do. God is without measure and since He is infinite everything about Him must also be infinite.

my id~ Limitless Through God

"I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works because I am going to be with the Father... and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth..."

~John 14:12-17

Jesus says we will do even greater things than He did here on earth because we will have the Holy Spirit as our advocate, filling us and empowering us to do these things according to his purpose.



my id- Limitless Through God

"Let this mind be in you which was also in Jesus Christ."

~Philippians 2:5

"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is his good, pleasing and perfect will. "

~Romans 12:2

Our minds can limit us, but if we have the mind of Christ then we can start to apply this limitless thinking in our lives. We do this by placing God's Word in our minds rather than what the world says. We align our will to God's will.

No matter what negativity you see around you say, "I'm going to think and set my mind on Christ who is limitless, so I can stand firm knowing with God there are no limits to what He can do in my life." His Spirit is alive and at work to empower us to think like Christ.

God's ID~ Holy

"Do not come any closer; God said: Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground."

~Exodus 3:5

God is majestic, pure and perfect. He has no sin or evil in Him at all. Wherever God has appeared, such as to Moses at the burning bush, that place becomes holy just because God is there.

my id~ Holy in His Sight

"As God's obedient children, never again shape your lives by the desires that you followed when you didn't know better. Instead, shape your lives to become like the Holy One who called you. For scripture says: 'You are to be holy because I am holy.'"

~1Peter 1:14-16

When we realize God is perfect, majestic and completely pure we identify as holy because of who we are in Him. We are held blameless because we are washed by Jesus' blood and called saints. Our holiness creates a desire to follow His precepts of truth because we know His plan is best for our life.

God's ID~ Love

"Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love. God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is real love-not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins."

~1 John 4:7-10

God's priority is to love and care for us. Love in action is Jesus sacrificing himself to save us from the death of sin. This is the ultimate act of love. God's love is unconditional as it does not change by emotions or feelings. God cannot love us any more or less than He loves us right now.

my id~To Love

"Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other. No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is brought to full expression in us."

~1 John 4:11

We were created by God to love and to grow in His love as Jesus loved us. Because we are believers in Jesus God's Spirit lives inside us, so we can obtain and overflow with God's love from within. We love each other because He first loved us.

God's ID~ Faithful

"So God has given both His promise and His oath. These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to Him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us. This hope is a secure and trustworthy anchor for our souls. It leads us through the curtain into God's inner sanctuary. Jesus has already gone in there for us. He has become our eternal High Priest in the order of Melchizedek."

~Hebrews 6:18-20

Everything that God does is true, therefore everything He has promised has always been and will be fulfilled. The Bible is full of examples of God's faithfulness from the beginning to the end. The most life-changing promise is that of God sending His son Jesus to die for our sins. God established Jesus to be the author of our salvation so that we may spend eternity with Him.



my id- We are Given Faith

"Because of the privilege and authority God has given me, I give each of you this warning: Don't think you are better than you really are. Be honest in your evaluation of yourselves, measuring yourselves by the faith God has given us."

~Romans 12:3

God has given us the gift of faith to apply in all areas of our life. Faith shows the reality of what we hope for and is the evidence of things we cannot see.

Faith gives us confidence in what God has promised and is to come. As we hear the Word our faith it is made strong, providing us with hope.

God's ID~ The Three In One

"Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation, for through Him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on the earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through him and for him. He existed before anything else, and he holds all creation together."

~Colossians 1:15~17NLT

"The earth was formless and empty, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters."

~Genesis 1:2

God reveals himself as Our Father, Son, and The Holy Spirit. God is all of these in one and cannot be divided. All three were involved in the creation.

my id- Relationship With The Trinity

"And God has given us his Spirit as proof that we live in him and he in us.

Furthermore, we have seen with our own eyes and now testify that the Father sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. All who declare that Jesus is the Son of God have God living in them, and they live in God. We know how much God loves us, and we have put our trust in his love."

~1 John 4:13-16

We delight in God because He creates out of His overflowing love for us. In creation you see His love, generosity and kindness displayed in the stars that shine through the darkness and the vastness of the oceans. The beauty God brings through His desert sands, high peaked mountains, and colorful sunsets show us how great He is.

my id- Relationship With The Trinity

In the Old Testament, only the high priest could engage with God. Before the high priest entered God's presence in the tabernacle he had to perform sacrifices to atone for his sins. The high priest would die from the presence of God's Glory if he had not properly atoned for his sins. As the only one allowed to enter the Holy of Holies (the furthest room back in the tabernacle) the high priest would tie a rope around his ankle and put bells on his waist so that if he should fall dead others would know and drag his body out.

God sending Jesus to be our sacrifice is a powerful reminder of how Holy our God is and how much He loves us. We have Jesus Christ as our High Priest and He provides access to the Father.

God sent Jesus to bear stripes, die on the cross and be raised to life taking all our diseases, pain and suffering and by doing so we may have eternal life. He then sent the Holy Spirit to be our guide, counselor and advocate while we are here on earth. The Holy Spirit speaks to us providing wisdom and knowledge and understanding. The power of The Holy Spirit gives us capacity for things we are not capable of on our own. We now delight in our relationship with God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit all in one.

God's ID~ All-knowing

"Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account."

~Hebrews 4:13

God knows everything, and His knowledge is infinite. It is impossible to hide anything from God for He sees absolutely everything. In our relationship with Him through Christ are all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

my id~ God Gives Me Knowledge

"So we have not stopped praying for you since we first heard about you. We ask God to give you complete knowledge of His will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding. Then the way you live will always honor and please the Lord, and your lives will produce every kind of good fruit. All the while, you will grow as you learn to know God better and better."

~Colossians 1:9-10



my id- God Gives Me Knowledge

Once we are saved and receive our new nature in Christ, we renew our minds through reading the Word and become more like Him.

God gives us the knowledge we need to live a life with moral excellence, self-control, endurance and affection to love everyone.

As we grow in this, we will become productive and useful in our knowledge of Jesus Christ.

God's ID~ All-powerful

"Great is Our Lord and mighty in power,
His understanding has no limit."

~Psalm 147:5

God's power has no limits! We can live in the full confidence that we have rest as we give our burdens and trials over to God. God is all-powerful in creation, salvation, and resurrection. There is no one as powerful or more powerful than God. Because God is good, pure and true, we should live with the full assurance that His power is enough to handle any of the situations we face in life.

my id~ Authority in Christ by His Holy Spirit

"Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever, Amen!"

~Ephesians 3:20

God's power dwells inside us through His Holy Spirit. God gives us His power so that we can live our life according to His will. Nothing is too hard for us as we obtain full confidence in the power of His Holy Spirit to give us strength. God makes all things possible through His power in us!

God's ID~ The Creator

"Before the mountains were born, before you gave birth to the earth and the world, from beginning to end, you are God."

~Psalm 90:2

When God spoke to Moses at the burning bush in Exodus 3:14 and said, "I AM WHO I AM." It was God revealing that He has the power to be in and of himself. God is completely independent.

There is no one else that has been self-created but God. It is hard to wrap our minds around that concept when everything else we encounter came from something other than itself. God's display through creation produces awe and wonder in His magnificent glory.

my id~ Dependence on My Creator

"I depend on God alone; I put my hope in Him. He alone protects and saves me; He is my defender, and I shall never be defeated. My salvation and honor depend on God; He is my strong protector; He is my shelter."

~Psalm 62:5-7

Unlike God who has an independent existence, we as human beings have a dependent existence to God. God created our spirits to depend only on Him and to exist eternally through Salvation. He created us in His image to choose salvation here on earth and spread the Good News for others to come to know Jesus Christ and glorify Him.

God's ID~ Self-Sufficient

"The Father has life in himself, and he has granted that same life-giving power to His Son. And He has given Him authority to judge everyone because He is the Son of Man."

~John 5:26-27

God has no needs. He possesses within himself divine qualities and abilities that are limitless. God is "The Almighty" and gave us life in this universe as a gift. God does not need our help, rather He placed us on this earth out of love and grace. God allows us to be a part of advancing His plan on earth to bring others to know Him and to be a blessing to them.

my id- Sufficient Need for God

"Such is the confidence that we have through Christ toward God. Not that we are sufficient in ourselves to claim anything as coming from us, but our sufficiency is from God, who has made us sufficient to be ministers of a new covenant, not the letter but of the Spirit."

~2 Corinthians 3:4-6

God has qualified and made us competent to share who Jesus is with others. It is by God's grace that we receive grace that is undeserved. We need God's grace to be able to look at life the way God does. His grace is more significant than our failures, weaknesses and our flawed self-image: it is sufficient for us.

God's ID~ Justice

"For I the Lord, love justice, I hate robbery and wrongdoing. In my faithfulness, I will reward my people and make an everlasting covenant with them."

~Isaiah 61:8

God loves us and is a just God. His love for us is so intense that He gave His son Jesus Christ so that we would not have to face judgment. God's justice, love and mercy all interlace with one another.

God is the supreme judge and even though we deserve to be judged He provides a way through Jesus for our immunity.

my id~ Free to Trust God's Justice

"But let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream."

~Amos 5:24

When we seek out justice ourselves we are limited. God is limitless and His power flows freely from His holiness.

"It's in Christ's hands, for vengeance belongs to the Lord."

~Romans 12:19

In this broken world what a significant relief to know we don't have to merely rely on man for justice, but may trust that God is in full control. God has the final say, vengeance is His and He is always just.

God's ID~ Mercy

"But God still loved us with such great love. He is so rich in compassion and mercy. Even when we were dead and doomed in our many sins, he united us into the very life of Christ and saved us by his wonderful grace!"

~Ephesians 2:4-5 TPT

Mercy is who God is. God shows His mercy through the sacrifice of His only Son which leads us to a relationship with Him that is full of grace, unmerited favor.

my id~ Compassionate

"How satisfied you are when you demonstrate tender mercy! For tender mercy will be demonstrated on you."

~Matthew 5:7 TPT

When we display compassion to others it will return to us. We all have fallen short of the glory of God. To show mercy to one another is to forgive one another as Jesus forgave us.



God's ID~ Never Changing

"For I the Lord do not change; therefore you, o children of Jacob are not consumed."

Malachi 3:6

God never changes because He is perfect in every way. For something to change it would be implied that it might be improved or worsened. God's perfect character of eternal power, wisdom, holiness, justice, goodness and truth will always be the same perfection. He says "I am the same yesterday, today and forever."

my id~ Assurance

"Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the whole world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God."

~Psalm 90:2

As our creator God loves us. He will sustain us and He has a plan for our lives. He brings us security and comfort in knowing who He is and who we are. God is our anchor and we can be sure that He is constant, faithful and dependable to help us in this ever-changing world.

God's ID- Eternal

"The eternal God is your refuge, and his everlasting arms are under you. He drives out the enemy before you; he cries out, "Destroy them!"

~Deuteronomy 33:27

God is never-ending. God has always existed. There has never been a time without God. Before anything was created, God already was.

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."

~John 1:1

He never came into being and He will never stop existing. God is everlasting!

my id- Eternal Life

"For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life."

~John 3:16

Our eternity rests in believing by faith that Jesus came to save us from the penalties for our sins giving us an eternal inheritance. Because God is eternal everything he promises extends into eternity. Our hope, security, strength and redemption in Jesus are all eternal for us.

God's ID~ Goodness

"The Lord is good to everyone. He showers compassion on all his creation."

~Psalm 145:9

God is the source of all goodness. It doesn't come from the world.

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd sacrifices his life for His sheep."

~John 10:11

God's goodness is expressed through bringing His son Jesus to be our shepherd.

"I am the good shepherd; I know my own sheep, and they know me."

~John 10:14

Shepherds feed, lead and meet the needs of their sheep. God gives us our daily bread, His word. God leads us on the right path and because He is ALL good God meets our needs.

my id~ Blessed

Keep me safe, O God, for I have come to you for refuge. I said to the Lord, "You are my Master! Every good thing I have comes from you."

Psalms 16:1-2

Our goodness comes only from God who rescues and intervenes to redeem us. We can rest and trust in God's goodness in all circumstances which frees us to take those bold faith steps.

God's ID~ Grace

"For the law was given to Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ."

~John 1:17

Grace is an undeserving favor given to us by God sending His Son to die on the cross for us to receive eternal salvation.

"God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it."

~Ephesians 2:8-9

Grace is God's love and kindness towards us even when we don't deserve it.

my id- Saved By His Grace

"Each time he said, My grace is all you need. My power works best in your weakness."

~2 Corinthians 12:9

God's grace is all we need from Him. Grace given to us from God provides our eternal salvation and is sufficient to meet all of our needs.



my id~ Saved By His Grace

"God's marvelous grace has manifested in person, bringing salvation for everyone. This same grace teaches us how to live each day as we turn our backs on ungodliness and indulgent lifestyles, and it equips us to live self-controlled, upright, godly lives in this present age."

~Titus 2:11-12

Spiritual growth is gradual, each one of us is different and unique in the way of God's timing. Grace transforms our desires, motivations, and behaviors as it empowers us to live for God.

God's ID~ Peace

"Now may the Lord of peace himself give you his peace at all times and in every situation. The Lord be with you all."

~2 Thessalonians 3:16

Our Lord is the God of Peace, therefore He is the provider of peace that is unimaginable for us in all circumstances we face in life.

my id~ Peace

"Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus."

~Philippians 4:6-7

Prayer gets rid of worry. We need to trust God when He says, "Tell me what you need and be grateful." When we trust, God provides us with a peace that is unexplainable as it shields our hearts and minds. If we ask and trust then peace from Him is the result.

God's ID~ Always Present

"The Lord replied, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

~Exodus 33:14

~Hebrews 13:5

God's presence and care for us at all times shows us there are no restricted locations or moments for God. God transcends the Universe and all that He created.

my id~ God Is With Me

"If I go up to heaven, you are there; if I go down to the grave, you are there. If I ride the wings of the morning, if I dwell by the farthest oceans, even there your hand will guide me, and your strength will support me. I could ask the darkness to hid me and the light around me to become night but even in darkness I cannot hide from you... You watched me as I was being formed in utter seclusion, as I was woven together in the dark of the womb. You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed."

~Psalms 139: 8-16

God's presence was with us before we were even born. It is comforting to know how valuable we are to God. Whatever we do and wherever we go there is no place away from God's presence. Our life is entirely in His hands. He is our constant companion at all places and at all times!
